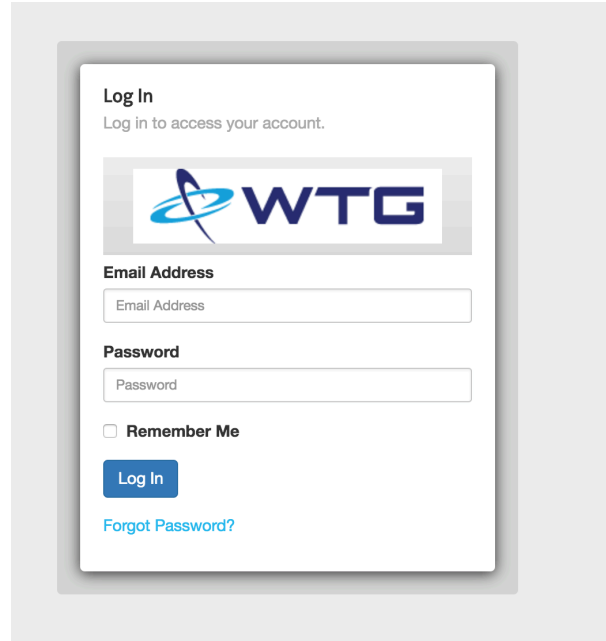

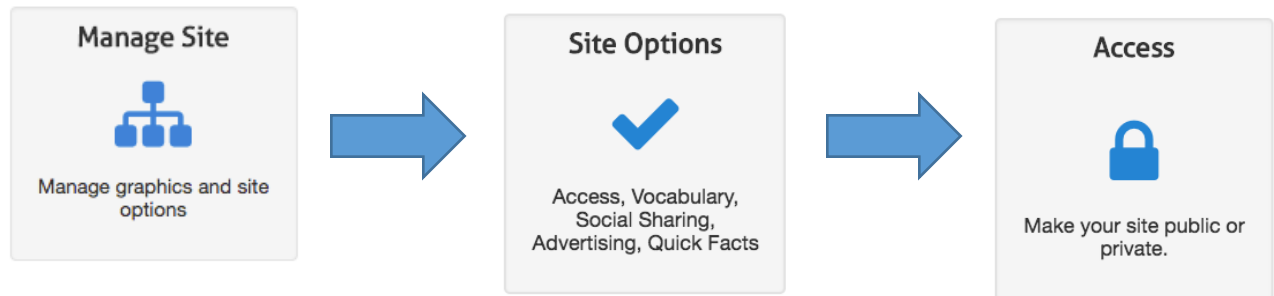
Site Access

How can I customize this feature?
